

GRAYMAN CUP - 1. 5. 2026

Competitor's Equipment List (CEL)

Competitors must start in all stages with all mandatory equipment according to their division!

1. GRAYMAN DIVISION (main division)

- 1.1. Eyes and Ears protection (active ear protection is highly recommended).
- 1.2. Semi-automatic pistol in hard case holster on the belt (fanny packs, armpit/shoulder holsters, soft holsters are not allowed). Appendix carry is optional and allowed. Revolvers are not allowed. Weapon mounted red-dots, lasers and flashlights are legal in the Czech Republic.
- 1.3. Clothing – full concealment is **mandatory** (check by SO in natural standing position). This division focuses on completely concealed carry with minimal visible signs of a weapon and weapon accessories like magazines, holsters (no “printing”). We recommend an outfit that looks as civilian as possible with an “overdressing” fun factor - office suits, dresses, outdoor clothing from non-military brands. No MOLLE webbings, military and gun-companies brands clothing allowed.
- 1.4. Shoes – civil outdoor firm shoes.
- 1.5. Minimum of 2 magazines up to maximum 20 rounds each. Shooter must be able to start with 35 rounds at least.
- 1.6. Maximum magazine capacity up to 20 rounds (20+1 for starting chambered).

2. LE/MIL DIVISION:

- 2.1. Eyes and Ears protection (active ear protection is highly recommended).
- 2.2. Semi-automatic pistol in hard case holster on the belt with retention (speed holsters are prohibited). Revolvers are not allowed. Weapon mounted red-dots, lasers and flashlights are legal in the Czech Republic.
- 2.3. Shooters or a service belt – leg strap is allowed.
- 2.4. Shoes – firm tactical shoes.
- 2.5. Plate carriers, helmets and other tactical gear is recommended but optional.
- 2.6. Minimum of 2 magazines up to maximum 20 rounds each. Shooter must be able to start with 35 rounds at least.
- 2.7. Maximum magazine capacity up to 20 rounds (20+1 for starting chambered).

3. SPORT OPEN DIVISION

- 3.1. Eyes and Ears protection (active ear protection is highly recommended).
- 3.2. Semi-automatic pistol in hard case holster covering the trigger on the belt (speed holsters allowed). Revolvers are not allowed.
- 3.3. Shoes – firm shoes
- 3.4. Shooters belt
- 3.5. Minimum of 2 magazines up to maximum 20 rounds each. Shooter must be able to start with 35 rounds at least.
- 3.6. Maximum magazine capacity up to 20 rounds (20+1 for starting chambered).
